Pre- and Post Test

Pre-test average score: ~91%

Post-test average score: ~96%

When asked, “I can apply the knowledge and skills gained in my work,” –
40% disagreed.



Post Workshop Satisfaction Questionnaire

Overall satisfaction: 100% *very satisfied and somewhat satisfied.*

Relevance: 94% agreed content was relevant to their roles

Recommendation rate: 100% would recommend

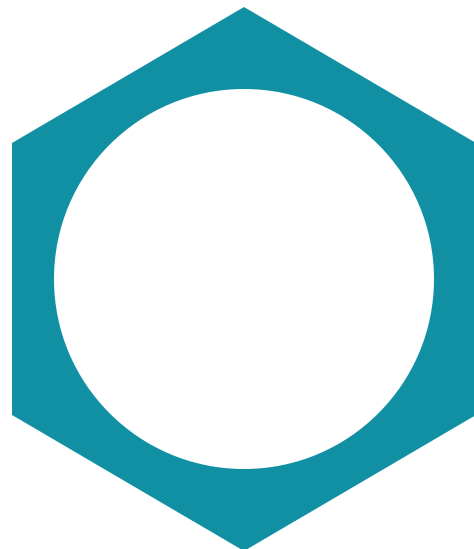
Focus Group Discussion

2. Participants wanted more time to unpack frameworks and link them to action.

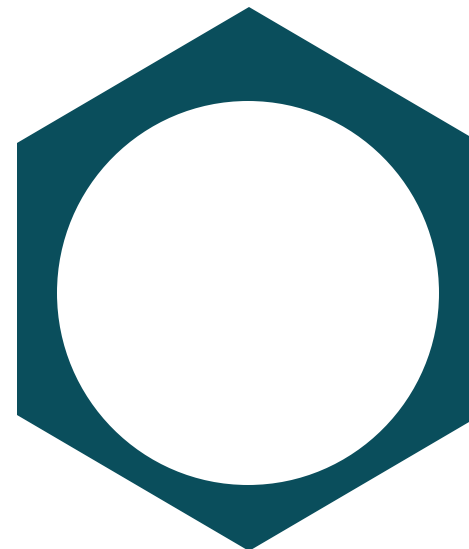
"I would need some more time... There were colours, and we couldn't talk too much on this table. And I would love to learn more about what kind of programs to implement."
