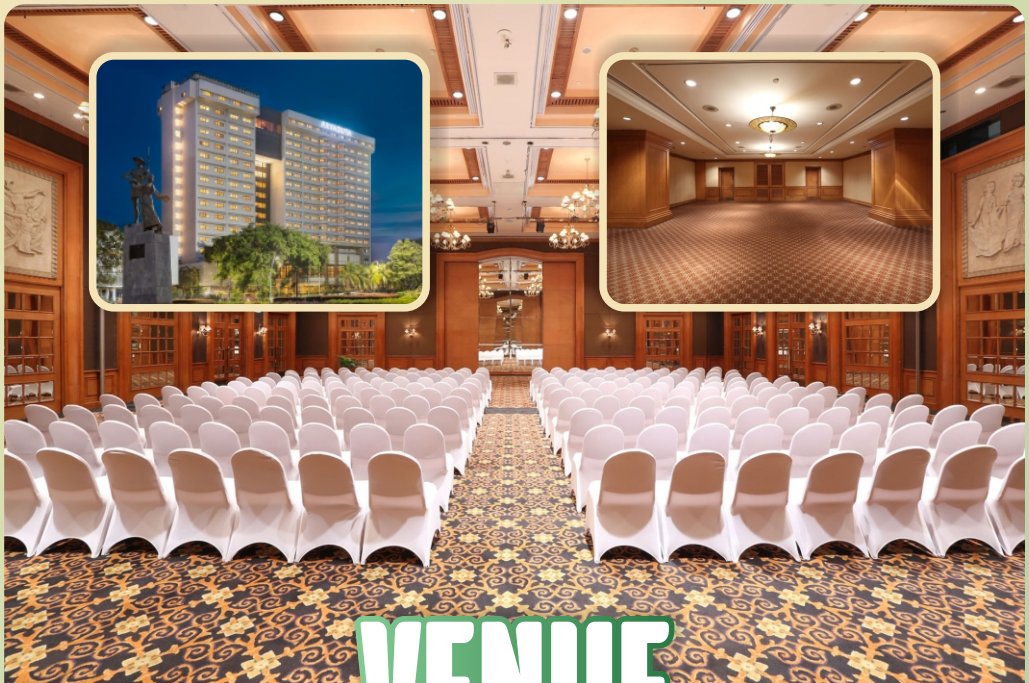

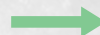
Abstract Submission Guideline

General Submission Rules

- Abstracts **must be submitted online** through the official website at apsaarcongress2026-jkt.com and received by the announced deadline. Any abstract submitted through other means or past the deadline **will not be accepted**.
- Each person may submit up to **4 abstracts**, regardless of whether they are the presenting author.
- Each person may serve as the presenting author for **one symposium session** and either an additional **poster or an oral presentation**.
- All of the listed authors must acknowledge the content of the abstract before submission.
- By submitting the abstract, all authors are made aware that acceptance will be for the official Congress publications and may be published by the Congress under the original authors' name.
- During the submission process, the submitter must provide clear details on each author's information, including:
 - Full first and family name(s)
 - Email address
 - Affiliations: department, institution/hospital, city, country
 - Phone number (completed with country's phone code)
- All abstracts must be written **in English** and stay within the topic lists.
- Session and Abstracts' title must be clear and concise, written in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx) in **BOLD** using Times New Roman font, 14 pt, centred. Avoid abbreviations or jargons in the title. The contents must be written the same font, 12 pt, justified.
- Any conflict of interest must be clearly stated by the submitters in the submission form.
- Each submission must be original and not have been previously published or presented at another conference.
- Abstracts should not contain commercial or promotional material, and only the generic name of drugs is permitted.
- Patient's name and other sensitive information should be concealed to protect patient confidentiality
- **A submission confirmation will be received via email**. Please contact the committee if a confirmation has not been received within 24 hours of submission. Do not submit the same abstract multiple times.

Session Proposal Submission Guidelines

- Please provide **a session abstract (max 250 words)** describing the main topic of the symposium, who will participate as speakers and chairs of the symposium, as well as the topics that they will address.
- The main topic of the session must align with the committee's listed topics to ensure relevance.
- Each proposal must include:
 - Title of the session
 - Brief introduction of the session (max 100 words)
 - Learning objectives of the session (max 4 outcomes)
 - The title of each sub-topic with the speaker details (full names, affiliations)
- All speakers and moderators **must be registered as a participant** to the Congress
- Each symposium session should include **3-4 speakers and 1 chair**, and the session must not exceed **90 minutes**.
- The chairperson will serve as the session moderator and may also participate as a speaker.
- Only a **maximum of two people** in the proposed symposium session **may be from the same country of origin**. Session proposals with 3 or more speakers/ chairs originating from the same country will be invalid and will not be considered.
- The proposal submission must be uploaded by the chairperson.

Abstract Submission Guideline

Oral Presentation/Poster Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Eligibility:
 - Oral/Poster presentations are open to students, researchers, clinicians, and academics in mental health.
 - Submitted abstracts must describe the authors' original work. We welcome submissions across a range of formats, including:
 - Original research (including but not limited to trials, cohort, case-control, cross-sectional, qualitative studies)
 - Case reports and case series
 - Study protocols and methods or validation studies (instrument development, psychometrics)
 - Reviews (systematic, scoping, narrative) and meta-analyses
- Please provide an abstract with a maximum of 250 words, excluding the title, authors' details, and references.
- Each submitter must clearly indicate their preferred presentation type, whether the abstract is intended for oral or poster presentation.
- Abstracts should be written clearly and structured using the following headings:
 - Background
 - Objectives
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion
 - References
 - Keywords (each abstract may submit up to 5 keywords)
- The presenting author must be registered as a participant to the Congress
